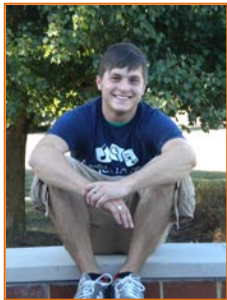

Work Experience: Jordan has worked with an emergency vet center for years. He is going into his third school year working with the Extended School Enrichment Program.

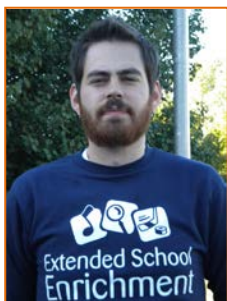
Fun Fact: Jordan loves writing songs and listening to music. He is has recently joined a new music group and plans to play shows very soon.

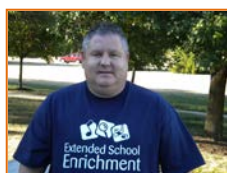

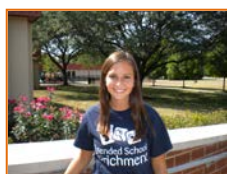
Fun Fact: Katie loves to watch SpongeBob every night.
