



Request for Modifications at the Waterpark

Requests Cannot Be Made:

Life jackets on slides	Requests cannot be made
Height on slides or FlowRider	Requests cannot be made
Two people on slides	Requests cannot be made

Always Need a Form & Inclusion Supervisor Approval

Non-Coast Guard Approved Floatation Devices	If a guest requests to wear water flotation devices that are not approved by the Coast Guard, a request modifications must be completed.
Holding Position in Waiting in Line for Attraction	If a guest requests to hold position in line for attractions because of disability, a request for modification form must be completed.

Doesn't Need a Form AND Pool Manager Can Approve*

Walking in Lazy River	A guest can enjoy the lazy river without a tube without a request for modification form. Must use stamp.
Catching at Bottom of Slides	If the child meets slide height requirements, a parent may catch their child at the bottom of the slides (not including dive well). Must use stamp.
Walkers in the Water	Guest may use personal walkers in the water as needed. Don't need to stamp.
Adaptive Tube	There is an adaptive tube which has the bottom in it, and guests may use this tube as needed. Don't need to stamp.
Extra time on FlowRider	If a guest requests extra ride time on the FlowRider because of disability, aquatics team will use best judgement.
Wearing an Item that Could Damage an Attraction.	If a guest requests to wear something on an attraction that could damage an attraction, aquatics team will use best judgement.
Pool Wheelchair	Guests can use the white pool wheelchair as needed. Do not need to stamp.

***Pool Manager should fill out FormStack log prior to approval.**
